

5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:

- * Parent involvement is encouraged throughout the school.
- * Parents are encouraged to assist with book fairs, classroom learning activities, field trips, field days, events, clean-up days and fund raisers.
- * Parents are encouraged to join and be an active part of the Parent Teacher Organization.
- * Teacher will provide parents information regarding opportunities for individual classroom involvement.
- * Text messaging, web site and social media will be used to communicate ways parent can be involved.
- * Weekly communication folders will be sent home for parents to sign and return.

6. Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.

* Teachers will contact parents using Remind, phone calls, emails and letters to communicate with parents of their child's progress.

* Interpreters will be present when needed at parent conferences.

* Print communication will be translated for the primary language of the home.

Parent Responsibilities


We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:
